Take Hold of Life that is Truly Life

Focus passage – Proverbs 3:5-6 *“Trust in the LORD with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding. In all your ways submit to him, and he will make your paths straight.”*

2) What is the first biblical principle Ben applied in his life?

3) What is the second biblical principle Ben applied in his life?

4) What is the third biblical principle Ben applied in his life?

5) How can 1 Timothy 6:17-19 be applied to our financial lives?

“Command those who are rich in this present world not to be arrogant nor to put their hope in wealth, which is so uncertain, but to put their hope in God, who richly provides us with everything for our enjoyment. Command them to do good, to be rich in good deeds, and to be generous and willing to share. In this way they will lay up treasure for themselves as a firm foundation for the coming age, so that they may take hold of the life that is truly life.” 1 Timothy 6:17-19

Commitment: I commit to learning and living by Proverbs 3:5-6..

Take Hold of Life that is Truly Life– LEADER'S GUIDE

1. Thank everyone for coming.
2. Open in prayer
3. Read the focus passage.
4. Ask men to answer Question #1.
5. Listen to the program: "Take Hold of Life that is Truly Life"
6. After the program is finished, allow time for comments or questions on the program
7. Review the answers to the four remaining questions with the men in the group.
Encourage everyone to participate, but never force or shame someone into participating.
 - a. Question #2 answer: Ben had daily quiet times with God.
 - b. Question #3 answer: Study, meditation, and memorization of God's word.
 - c. Question #4 answer: A life that is truly life is one that stores up treasures in Heaven.
 - d. Question #5 answer: Review the commands that are found in these verses and discuss how they can be applied in the lives of the men.
8. Ask the men what was most important to them from this teaching.
9. Ask men to commit to learning and living by Proverbs 3:5-6.
10. Confirm the time for the next meeting
11. Take prayer requests.
12. Close in prayer

Sample prayer: Almighty God, please help us to live by the truths found in Proverbs 3:5-6 and trust you in all our ways. In Jesus name, Amen.
